Judi Liechty was sworn in as a board member. Judy is the operations manager of the Keizer food bank.

Guest speaker: Ben Crosby - Code compliance dept, city of Keizer Ben has been working for Keizer for 8 years and started on graffiti compliance, not criminalization.

Lately the code compliance dept has been pursuing individuals that have been caught tagging or that the investigations have led to being the tagger.

The code enforcement dept has a portal where people can report graffiti, the process is as follows:

- 1- submit complaint with photos and then after that, they can be cleaned by the individual or wait for the city to clean up.
 - 1.1. if individual is cleaning up, they can use what they have or request a cleaning kit from the office.
 - 1.2 resubmit a ticket on the portal and inform the office that they have cleaned up the graffiti. Include cross streets and Andy relevant information, also adding the date/time of the original submission is helpful.

The code compliance department is working on a system to "check out" the graffiti kits to the public when needed.

Griffin will add more information and relevant links from Ben's presentation to the web site to make sure they are easy to find.
