- **Event: National Night Out**

- **Event: Candidate Forum - Wed, October 21st 6 – 7:30pm**

- a. Griff to reach out to Jonathan so he can MC the event.
- b. Questions solicitation: Previous instance, questions were provided on paper and then chosen by a person to be asked to the candidates. Questions based on category will be asked.
 - i. This time we will figure out a technological solution to gather questions at the event to then give to the MC to ask the candidates.

- **Lockhaven/Windsor Island Drive Intersection - Update (Dave and Hersh attended)**

- a. There will be a housing development across from the log house, 110 units, 40 townhouses and the rest will be single family homes.
- b. Start of the project unknown.

- c. No plan to improve intersection, and KPD does not support doing so.

- **Street Art**

- a. Tammy showed the colors that were purchased.
 - i. Coverage has been discussed.
 - 1. 300 sq feet per gallon.
 - 2. At 77 degrees it dries to the touch within 30 mins; up to 4 hours to allow traffic. Surface temperature should be under 110 degrees to apply. They will hold on to the paint and we can come get it there when we are ready. Supplies can be purchased from Sherwin-Williams. Tammy will plan what supplies are needed.
 - ii. Griffin working on prepping the graphic for enlargement onto road
- b. Griff, Tammy and Crista met with Rachel and mom Krissy earlier in the month.
- c. Installation planned for October or planning for spring to paint the artwork, weather dependent.
- d. Public works street prep by Public Works - we don't want this to be a precedent. Tammy will discuss this with Mike Griffin. Currently KPW has agreed to pressure wash the intersection ahead of art placement.

- **Door Hanger Distribution**

- a. We will distribute only to those homes that are safe in September ahead of 9/16 General Meeting. Neighborhood map was shared and areas distributed amongst board members.

- **SKPS Community Micro-gatherings**

- a. **No updates at this time.** Caleb Roberts reached out from SKPS about community micro-gatherings this summer.

- **Other Board Business**

- a. Storm drain art installation will be on July 29th - 31st at Alder in front of Weddle MS.
